



COMMITTED PROJECTS FOR LAWRENCE AND DOUGLAS COUNTY



The following is the list of committed projects for Lawrence & Douglas County. A committed project is a transportation related improvement that is planned for and money already allocated for or is expected to be allocated. These projects are either ongoing or soon-to-be constructed projects throughout the Lawrence community and Douglas County.

Committed Projects include:

City of Lawrence Roadway Improvements

- Crossgate Drive - South of Clinton Parkway - Two-lane City standard upgrade New traffic signal @ Clinton & Crossgate - Roundabout @ 24th Place
- Inverness Drive - South of Clinton Parkway - creation of a "4-lane" road way - (two lanes thru, two lanes parking lanes w/ two roundabouts) - one at 24th Place and Sunflower Park Place
- Louisiana Street - Bicycle Pavement Markers & Pedestrian Refuges (Refuges located between: 19th & 20th, 20th & 21st, 22nd & Greever Terrace and 25th & Utah)
- North Michigan - Upgrade to City Standard Two-Lane Roadway (Sewer, Curb and Gutter)
- Riverridge Road Improvements: Upgrade to City Two-Lane Standard with Bicycle Lanes (Sewer, Curb and Gutter)
- 6th Street (U.S. 40) - Widening from Wakarusa to SLT to a four-lane roadway - **[Assistance provided by KDOT]**
- 27th - Inverness to Crossgate - Upgraded to City Two-Lane

City of Lawrence Intersection Improvements:

- Clinton Parkway & Hawthorn Drive - New Traffic Signal
- Clinton Parkway & Lawrence Avenue - New Mast Arm for Eastbound & Westbound Traffic, Additional Left Turn signal for East & West Bound Traffic & additional pedestrian signal on east leg
- 6th Street & Lawrence Avenue - New Mast Arm for Eastbound Traffic, Additional Left Turn signal for East Bound Traffic
- 6th Street & Kasold Drive **[Assistance requested from KDOT]**
- 19th & Barker - Roundabout
- 23rd & Barker - Additional Left Turn Lanes on 23rd Street
- 27th & Iowa - Double left-Turn Lanes & Medians on 27th
- K-10 & East Hills Drive - Geometric Improvements (Additional Stacking Capacity **[Assistance provided by KDOT]**)

City of Baldwin Improvements:

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- Route 1055 (6th Street) – U.S 56 to High Street - Grading and Surfacing

City of Eudora Improvements:

- E 2100 Rd. (Winchester Road) - Kansas Highway 10 to Route 442 – Grading and Resurfacing

Douglas County Improvements:

- Kasold Drive 31st to K-10/SLT Improvements - Upgrade to City Two-Lane from County Gravel
- Route 438 Surfacing (Farmer's Turnpike) 1029 to Lawrence - includes wide shoulders for bicycle traffic/farm traffic
- Noria Road - 15th Street Extended (N 1500 Rd) to East Hills Business Park East Entrance - Upgrade to wide two-lane from county gravel
