- 1. Meeting Called to Order:** The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 5:25 pm.

- 4. Discussion Item: Update on Burrough's Creek**  
Kelsy Marr updated the committee on the TE grant. KDOT toured the site with City representatives and are currently in the review process. The city plans to hear back from KDOT in mid-May.
- 5. Discussion Item: 2006 Project Goals**  
Kelsy Marr distributed lists of bicycle projects to look over and decide on 6-8 projects to be put into the CIP for 2006.
- 6. Discussion Item: Relocation of BAC meetings**  
The committee discussed the option of relocating to a more convenient meeting place. A general consensus concluded to move the meetings to the new Fire Station #5 off Iowa and 19<sup>th</sup> St. starting in April.
- 7. Other Business: Speed Bump on Folks Rd. (S of 6<sup>th</sup>)**  
Eric Struckhoff passed out pictures of the speed bump located on Folk's Rd. south of 6<sup>th</sup> St. There have been a number of injuries on this bump and was advised to reconfigure the layout of the bump. Possible solutions that were discussed included removing the bump and reducing the angle of the cushion. The committee decided it would be best to reduce the angle for easier riding. Kelsy Marr will contact David Woosley in regards to the speed bump alteration.
